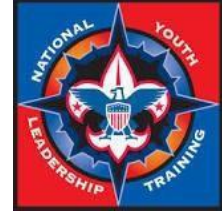




## National Youth Leadership Training Application Adult Staff Application Istrouma Area Council Boy Scouts of America



### What is the NYLT Adult Staff's Job?

The NYLT adult staff is responsible for developing and advising the youth staff while they plan and conduct the National Youth Leadership Training under the guidance of the course Scoutmaster. All staff will work together to create a rich learning environment for the Scouts they are serving and for themselves.

### Who is Eligible?

To be considered for NYLT adult staff, the adult:

- Must be at least 21 years old.
- Has held or will hold a leadership position in a Troop or Crew.
- Should obtain a recommendation to serve from a member of your District or Council leadership.
- Completion of Wood Badge is recommended
- A 2-year commitment requested for ASMs

### What Will I Do?

As an adult staff member, you will serve in one of the following positions:

**Assistant Scoutmaster (2):** As in any Scout troop, the Assistant Scoutmaster serves as a mentor for Assistant Senior Patrol Leaders. He/she is empowered by the NYLT Scoutmaster to ensure that the youth they mentor is prepared for their duties.

*General Duties of the **Assistant Scoutmasters** include:*

- Serving as a backup for the Scoutmaster
- Sharing in the administration of the NYLT course
- Modeling core learning and leadership messages of the NYLT syllabus
- Handling any issues that arise that could detract the Course Director from the primary role of guiding and coaching the Course Leader and other youth staff
- Providing support for the staff training
- Recruiting youth participants

*Duties of the **Assistant Scoutmaster for Program** include development and mentoring of the ASPL for Program in:*

- Providing mentoring and coaching to each day's program patrol
- Overseeing the preparation of campfires
- Presenting Course material
- Supporting NYLT presenters with preparations for sessions, meetings, and activities
- Overseeing audiovisual support for NYLT sessions
- Modeling the core learning and leadership messages of the NYLT syllabus
- Completing other assignments as determined by the senior patrol leader
- Recruiting youth participants

*Duties of the **Assistant Scoutmaster for Service** include development and mentoring of the ASPL for Service in:*

- Providing mentoring and coaching for each day's service patrol

- Overseeing preparations of the model campsite on the Orientation Trail (Day One of the NYLT course)
- Presenting Course material
- Conducting daily campsite inspections & guiding patrols in complying with the Daily Campsite Inspection Checklist
- Teaching the daily service patrols to police and clean up troop areas with a Leave No Trace ethic
- Manage presentations of the Baden-Powell Patrol streamers
- Completing other assignments as determined by the Senior Patrol Leader
- Recruiting youth participants

**Quartermaster:** The role of the NYLT Adult Quartermaster is similar to that of the Adult Quartermaster in a Scout troop.

*Duties of an **Adult Quartermaster** include development and mentoring of the youth Quartermaster in:*

- Management of course equipment to patrols; including inventory management, distribution procedures
- Organization and distribution of food to patrols on daily basis
- Modeling the core learning and leadership messages of the NYLT syllabus
- Completing other assignments as determined by the Assistant Senior Patrol Leader for service
- Recruiting youth participants

**Health and Safety Officer:** The role of the NYLT Health and Safety Officer is to ensure safety precautions are taken during the course. The Health and Safety Officer must be First-Aid certified.

*Duties of the Health and Safety Officer include:*

- Reviewing medical forms prior to the start of the course
- Administering medications at the appropriate times and usages
- Performing first-aid when needed
- Recruiting youth participants

**Kitchen Staff:** The role of the NYLT Kitchen Staff is to help prepare food for the course participants.

*Duties of the Kitchen Staff include:*

- Overseeing a youth kitchen staff
- Preparing meals that are to be served to course participants
- Cleaning up kitchen and cooking utensils
- Preparation of snacks
- Recruiting youth participants

**How much of a time commitment will I have to make?**

- Course Dates are May 26 – May 31, 2019 at Avondale Scout Reservation (ASR).
- Staff reports on May 25 by 9:00 AM and will be finished no later than June 1 at 1:00 PM.
- Staff will have 4 weekends of training and preparation prior to the course. Attendance is required.

**Staff Fee: \$100.00** (covers food and costs during staff developments and course)

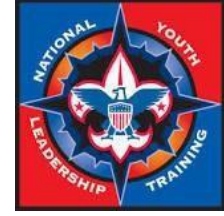
